

AN IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT YOUR GAS RATES

January 2024

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has approved changes to the rates Enbridge Gas charges customers effective Jan. 1, 2024. A summary of the rate changes and the updated **Rate T1** schedule can be found at enbridgegas.com. Changes to supplemental service rates reflect changes in gas supply costs effective Jan. 1, 2024.

Federal Carbon Charge

The federal carbon charge is 12.39 ¢/m³. This charge increases annually each April. All of the money collected for this charge goes to the government. Some businesses may be eligible for full or partial exemption from this charge under the federal carbon pricing program.

Effective Jan. 1, 2024, the facility carbon charge will decrease to 0.0157 ¢/m³. This charge will be common for all customers in each Enbridge Gas rate zone.

Storage and Transportation

Approved 2024 storage and transportation rate changes are reflected in the new rates for Rate T1 customers. Individual customer impacts will vary.

Enbridge Gas' storage and transportation rates also reflect changes in the costs for compressor fuel and unaccounted for gas due to changes in the cost of gas. In addition, where Enbridge Gas provides storage deliverability inventory, there is a change to the carrying cost of gas in inventory due to the changes in the cost of gas. Individual customer impacts will vary based on usage.
